

## Translation, Interpretation and Tutoring Services

The Division of World Languages, Literatures and Cultures does not offer translation, tutoring, or interpretation services. University of Iowa students may be able to utilize the resources below:

- **Autonomous Language Learning Network (ALLNet)** - The Division of World Languages, Literatures and Cultures (DWLLC) offers an opportunity to learn critical and less commonly taught languages. This is open to the University of Iowa students, faculty, and staff interested in study and research abroad. Many international opportunities require communication skills in a language NOT currently taught at the University of Iowa. With the support of the ALLNet staff members, learners design their own study plans to learn basic language skills or improve upon existing skills in preparation for study and research abroad. Upon admission into the program, the learners will be provided with learning materials and tutorial sessions with a trained native speaker.
- **Conversation Hours** – Programs and department throughout the Division host weekly or frequent conversation hours to practice language skills. These are informal and open to University students of all speaking abilities. Contact individual department(s) for details on scheduled events.
- **Academic Resource Center** - Ground Floor, IMU, 319-353-2747 Open for tutoring and supplemental instruction Sunday – Thursday. Sessions are free, drop-in, group tutoring. Students should bring their student ID and course notes to check-in. Makes available to students listings of upper-level or graduate students who are qualified tutors in various academic areas.

- **Language Media Center** – 120 PH, 319-335-2331 - Provides students with facilities and services for traditional language laboratory work as well as for foreign language video and computer-based activities
- **Spanish Writing Center** – Make a 30-minute appointment on the sign-up sheet or check with the Spanish Department for the current week or the upcoming week for assistance in many upper-level Spanish classes – located in Phillips Hall.
- **Speaking Center** – 412 EPB, 319-335-0205 - Provides individual instruction to improve speaking skills, free of charge. Assistance provided on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- **TRiO Student Support Services** – 24 PH, 319-335-1288 - Provides free tutoring for qualified students.
